- 1) **Planning Commission:** Acts in an advisory capacity to Town Council in planning the development of the Town (subdivisions, rezoning's, parks, etc.).
- 2) **Industrial Development Authority:** Assist in promoting industry and developing trade in the area through financial assistance to new and existing industries.
- 3) **Board of Zoning Appeals:** Hears requests for zoning appeals for relief in special cases where there may be a hardship.
- 4) **Transportation Safety Commission:** Plays a proactive role as the sounding board for local transportation safety concerns and encourages transportation safety initiatives.
- 5) **Southside Planning District Commission:** Promotes the orderly and efficient development of the physical, social and economic elements of the regions by planning.
- 6) **VASAP BOARD:** Provides probation, education and rehabilitation of those persons charged with alcohol related driving violations.
- 7) **Lake County Development Corporation:** Administers low interest revolving loan fund to promote job creation in the region.
- 8) **Halifax County-South Boston Regional Library Board:** Sets library policy, prepares development and program plan and reviews policy and planning of the Library member organizations.
- 9) **Community Arts Center Foundation (The Prizery):** Supports the arts community
- 10) **Halifax County Improvement Council:** Advise and educate public through development of a litter control and recycling plan to improve Halifax County.
- 11) **Halifax County Recreation Advisory Board:** Improve recreation activities for all citizens.
- 12) **Board of Viewers:** Make recommendations to on public right of way closing requests.
- 13) **Halifax County Public Service Authority:** Provides reliable, dependable water & sewer services that enhance quality of life while operating on sound fiscal and utility principles.
